TEEN AND ADULT VOLUNTEERS AT THE WEST PHILADELPHIA YMCA
COME TOGETHER FOR A "DAY OF SERVICE"

Volunteers at the West Philadelphia YMCA will celebrate National Youth Service Day and Earth Day with a beautification project on Saturday, April 21st

PHILADELPHIA – April 17, 2007- Volunteering creates positive morale and a powerful sense of accomplishment. That's why the West Philadelphia YMCA, located at 5120 Chestnut Street in West Philadelphia is celebrating two national initiatives with one day of community service on **Saturday, April 21st from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m.** In recognition of National Youth Service Day on Saturday, April 21st and Earth Day on Sunday, April 22nd, the YMCA of Philadelphia & Vicinity is hosting a "Day of Service" at all of its ten branches. National Youth Service Day is the nation's largest service event for youth and is an opportunity to introduce, educate and engage young people in the importance of community service and volunteer work.

Dozens of adult volunteers from Greater Philadelphia Cares will work side by side with teen volunteers from YMCA Youth Programs such as Y Achievers and Y Leaders Clubs on a beautification project at the West Philadelphia YMCA. Activities scheduled for the day include painting, landscaping, planting flowers, mulching and cleaning of the grounds.
